

## Current Opportunity: Associate Director – Data Management

We have an exciting opportunity for an Associate Director – Data Management in our Chippenham or Cambridge, UK office.

- The Associate Director – Data Management will act as the Data Manager for the clinical programmes, focusing on data management input to the programme and vendor oversight to ensure delivery of the database within defined quality, timeline and budget limits. The role also entails ensuring accurate and appropriate clinical trial data management processes are undertaken according to relevant regulations including ICH GCP.

### The Role

- To manage all data management requirements in a timely fashion
- To manage data management aspects of projects outsourced to CROs
- To ensure CRO design for data capture tools (e.g. EDC, eDiary) is appropriate for clinical trial protocol
- To ensure that appropriate procedures are followed during the data management process to obtain a “clean” database for statistical analysis
- To ensure appropriate data management plans are developed
- To review database build, edit checks and data cleaning undertaken by other data managers at a CRO
- To provide expert oversight of CROs and management of budgets
- To undertake appropriate User Acceptance Testing of electronic system used in clinical trials including: eDiaries, electronic data capture systems and edit checks
- To draft or review data management SOPs, as required to support data integrity
- To develop standard CRF forms and associated edit checks?
- To manage the transfer and retention of clinical trial databases from CROs following completion of the CSR
- To be the point of contact within the company and to provide expert advice throughout the company for all data management issues.
