Report RIDDOR accidents for the Group and maintain all safety records inclusive of accident and statistical returns in compliance with legislation. Compile and analyse statistical data including incidents and hazards and provide regular Health & Safety reports to the Director of HSE. Identify staff training needs in relation to HSE and develop management controls to ensure training needs, delivering training or source training providers as appropriate. You will be responsible for site management at the Chippenham location. Implement environmental solutions and drive changes in processes/systems. Support the Director – HSE & Facilities with the management of the HSE budget.

It is essential that you hold a Health & Safety qualification, as a minimum GradIOSH or CMIOSH accreditation, possessing a NEBOSH Diploma along with relevant experience gained within the pharmaceutical industry and a GMP environment.
